### Documents Needed for your appointment:

1. Your Social Security Number
2. Your driver's license, if applicable, or Florida ID
3. Your last two years of Federal Income Tax Returns (Signed)  
-And your spouse's if you are married
4. Your birth certificate  
-Your citizenship card; your alien registration card (if you are not a U.S. citizen)  
or an I-94 from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) showing immigrant status.
5. If applicable:  
-If renewing FAFSA application, your FAFSA ID  
-Your high school diploma or high school equivalency credential (i.e. GED)  
-The last two years of untaxed income records: Social Security Benefit,  
Temporary Assistance, Welfare, or Veterans Benefits records  
-Your most current bank statements

**\*If you are a dependent student (i.e. less than 24 years old, unmarried, or do not have children) then you will need most of the above information of your parent(s).**
